To develop in the students the competencies required: to integrate harmoniously into the school and work environments; to apply preventive measures in the workplace; to understand the underlying principles of caring for patients in health-care establishments; to perform the tasks of the occupation; and to perform the tasks of the occupation under real working condition and in various types of health-care establishments.
